'Ready, Steady, Grow!'

RE	<p>Special People We will revisit how the parish family celebrates and learn that there are special people in our lives who are there to help. On Sunday, in Church, we meet people who do special jobs as we gather to celebrate the Good News of Jesus.</p> <p>Gathering We will recall how the parish celebrate at Mass. We will find out about how families share special meals and that Mass is Jesus' special meal.</p>
English	<p>'The Tin Forest' -COLD TASK- write a diary about events over the Christmas holiday. -Explanation texts - linked to science. -Unpick the vocabulary -Teach the children the story with the actions -Read the story and discuss -What are their likes, dislikes, patterns and puzzles? -Box the diary up. -Plan their own diary. -Write their own diary up. -HOT TASK- write a diary linked to working on the school allotment. Daily group reading in class - individual reading books for home.</p>
Maths	<p>The children will be continuing with their number work but beginning to focus on the skills of subtraction and multiplication. We will be solving problems involving subtraction and multiplication. They will be using practical apparatus including multilink, bar modelling, straws and numicon to support their learning. The children will continue to count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, from any given number.</p>
Science	<p>Plants We will continue to identify and name a variety of wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. The children will learn about the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees through simple investigations. We will continue observe the seasonal changes and weather patterns around us as the nights get lighter. We'll discuss how the length of the day varies. Please keep a look out for the early signs of Spring when you are out and about.</p>
Art	<p>Our artwork will focus on drawing, using pencils, chalks, charcoal and inks. The children will explore different textures and mark making, observing patterns in the natural and man-made world. We will learn about the artist Henri Rousseau.</p>
Geography	<p>We will be studying <i>Our city - Liverpool</i> and its place in the UK. We will visit Liverpool city to see the landmarks e.g The Three Graces, Cathedrals, Tate Liverpool, Royal Albert Dock</p>
Computing	<p>We Are All Connected Project Evolve Be internet ALERT - Managing Online Information - We will understand that information online can be good and bad. We will recognise common uses of information technology beyond school.</p>
PE	<p>Sending and receiving Throwing and catching, rolling, kicking, tracking and stopping a ball.</p>
PSHE	<p>Going for goals Mrs Klein will be working with the children to explore their hopes, dreams and goals for their futures.</p>
